Guidelines (not just for the contest, but in general):

- 1. "Promposals" during class time will be disqualified.
- 2. Any that are disruptive to the school environment or leave a mess will be disqualified.
- 3. Disqualifications will be made by the junior class advisors.
- 4. Think about the "receivers" end, as well, when you plan for your PromPosal.

 Questions to ponder: "Would she like to be put in a spotlight in front of many people?" "Would she feel awkward by being asked by me in this way?"
- 5. Anything inappropriate will be referred to Mr. Frontiera.
- 6. The advisers will be looking for the most thoughtful, funniest, or sweetest PromPosals;
- "Promposals" should not leave the person feeling asked uncomfortable or embarrassed, and no points will be awarded for spending more money. Also, remember the promposal does NOT have to be in front of everyone to be sweet!
